Trucks and buses are only 10% of the vehicles on the road, but spew almost 50% of the pollution into our air.

For the first time in 20 years, the EPA is working on a rule to slash toxic pollution from trucks and buses. Some truck makers are undermining the adoption of strong standards through harmful industry lobbying with misleading claims.
