The State Funding Readiness Project (SFRP) provides free, fast, and flexible technical assistance to jurisdictions preparing for, applying for, and implementing funding from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) and the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA). We work with subnational jurisdictions—states, local governments, U.S. territories, Tribes, and community-based organizations—to help them unlock the full potential of federal climate investments and direct funding to ambitious, equitable climate projects. We are unique in our ability to deliver and streamline surge capacity and individualized services at no cost to jurisdictions increasingly faced with capacity and resource constraints.




The Case for Scaling

Progress to date has demonstrated the need and success of this model and its readiness to expand across the country.



Grant Application Support

- \$1.5B in total secured federal funding
- \$2.3B in total requested federal funding
- 12 federal programs supported
- 97% Justice40 programs



Foundational Readiness

- 200 federal funding programs identified
- 120 technical assistance resources identified
- 420 stakeholders mapped
- 80 workforce initiatives identified

Post-Award Implementation

Strategic opportunities to deploy awarded funds include the **Climate Pollution Reduction Grants (CPRG)** and the **Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (GGRF).**

CPRG Planning

SFRP can assist jurisdictions with Comprehensive Climate Action Plan (CCAP) components, such as:

- Intersection with other funding availability
- Workforce planning analysis
- Meaningful community and low-income disadvantaged communities (LIDAC) engagement

CPRG Implementation

SFRP can help jurisdictions with initiating their CPRG Implementation Grants, such as:

- Scope of Work (SOW) creation to hire contractors
- Job quality strategies and commitments
- Community, especially LIDAC, benefits analysis

GGRF Solar for All

SFRP can support jurisdictions with deployment of their Solar for All Grants, such as:

- Request for Proposal (RFP) creation to hire contractors
- Creation of robust workforce development plans
- LIDAC engagement and benefits analysis
